Engineer – Using tools and blocks, our little engineers built models and learned how engineers design and create.






Fire Fighter – Dressed in helmets, our little firefighters bravely acted out saving people from fire and keeping communities safe.




IDENTIFICATION CONTEST




ART & CRAFT ACTIVITY

Through this celebration, children not only enjoyed the colour theme but also learned about colour recognition, association, and expression in a playful manner.





At JUJU International Preschool, our teachers are more than educators—they are facilitators of curiosity, creativity, and confidence.











